The goal of any well-written book review should be to take the reader of the review through the major argument or arguments of the book with a critical eye, enabling readers of the review to locate the book within scholarly traditions.

Broadly, following two approaches can be adopted to write a book review. Descriptive review: This type of review generally provides the essential information about a book. This is written by exposition and description, and by stating the underlying aims of the author. Generally prominent passages from the book are mentioned in this type of review. Especially due to this descriptive approach, this type of reviews is not really common in academia.

What must a book review contain? Like all works of art, no two book reviews will be identical. But fear not: there are a few guidelines for any aspiring book reviewer to follow. Most book reviews, for instance, are less than 1,500 words long, with the sweet spot hitting somewhere around the 1,000-word mark.

Authors are welcome to submit Customer Reviews, unless the reviewing author has a personal relationship with the author of the book being reviewed, or was involved in the book ' s creation process (i.e. as a co-author, editor, illustrator, etc.). Your book review word count should fall within a range of 650-750 words, with most reviews about 700 words (including bibliographic information and reviewer information). In rare cases, when reviewers are writing about several books in one review, for instance, the book review editors will allow a higher word count.
