Pathogens standard does not specifically apply to occupational exposure to respiratory secretions, although saliva may contain respiratory secretions (and, in dentistry, the standard applies to occupational exposure to saliva).

Ideally, dental treatment should be provided in individual patient rooms, whenever possible. For dental facilities with open floor plans, to prevent the spread of pathogens there should be: At least 6 feet of space between patient chairs. Physical barriers between patient chairs.
